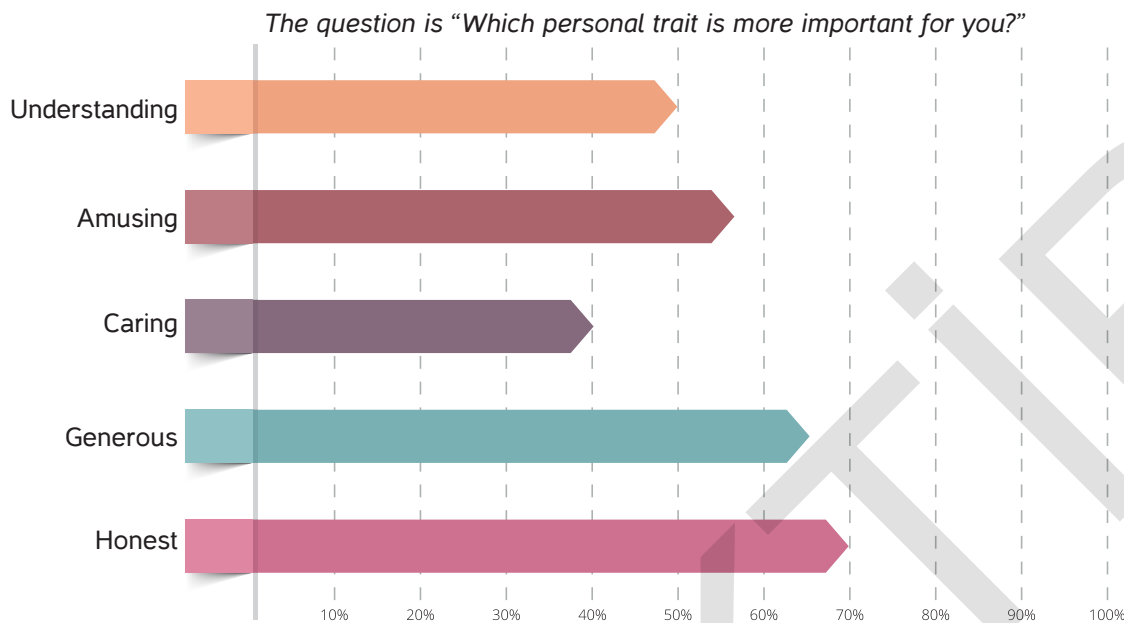

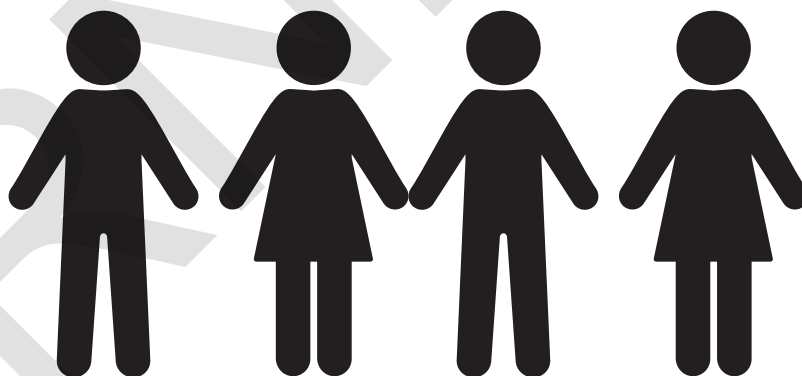

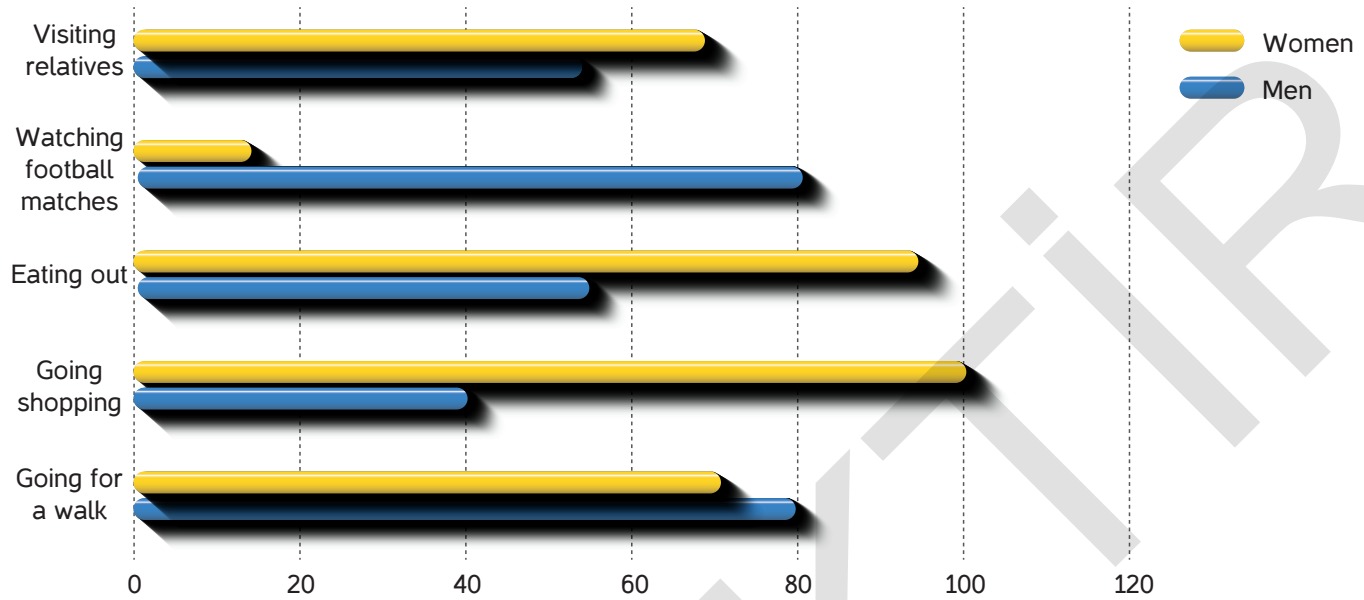

Free Time Activities of Men and Women



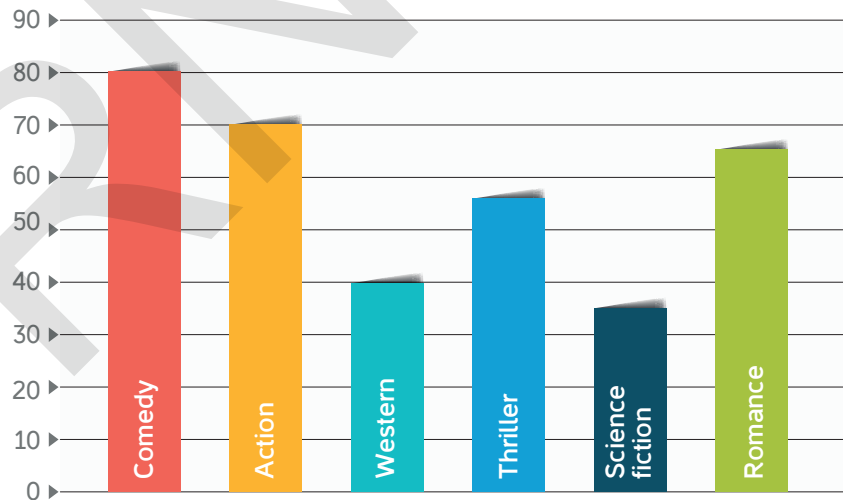
